We aim to help them acquire the foundation skills for present and future learning.

Our principles provide a framework for 'inclusive' Pre-School education:-

-  A child's right to share ordinary places i.e. attend the same school as peers
-  A child's right to choice i.e. not at an early age (where possible) being placed into a segregated setting
-  A child's right to contribute to society i.e. seen as having strengths and abilities, not someone with just disabilities
